DEACON SELECTION “ACCORDING TO SCRIPTURE, DEACON SELECTION IS BASED UPON AN INDIVIDUAL’S CHARACTER, COMMITMENT, AND SERVICE TO CHRIST AND HIS CHURCH”

A DEACON SHOULD:

Be above reproach, both inside and outside the church. <i>1 Tim.3:7,10</i>	Be one who manages his own household well, resulting in love and respect from his wife and children, if married. Be “the husband of one wife” with a demonstrated knowledge of the God-ordained institution of marriage. <i>1 Tim. 3:12</i>	Be a New Testament steward as evidenced by giving generously to First Baptist Church as God has prospered him, and tithe 10% of his income to the ministry of the church. <i>1 Cor. 16:1, 2</i>
Be filled with the Holy Spirit. <i>Acts 6:3</i>	Be a mature Christian, not a new convert. <i>1 Tim.3:6,10</i>	Do all in his power to create and preserve harmony in the church. <i>1 Tim. 3:13</i>
Not be self-centered, quick-tempered, violent or contentious. <i>1 Tim 3:3</i>	Know what he believes and be able to discern false doctrine and share the truth with others. <i>1 Tim.3:2,9,16</i>	Recognize the God-given leadership role incumbent upon the Pastor and seek to serve under that leadership. <i>Titus 1:5-9</i>
Abstain from any association with alcohol, drugs, etc. that would distort his testimony or cause another believer to stumble. <i>1 Tim. 3:3,8</i>	Be free from the love of money and diligently seek the kingdom of God and His righteousness. <i>1 Tim. 3:8; Matt. 6:33</i>	If married, be one whose wife is guided by these same principles. <i>1 Tim. 3:11</i>
Be in control of his tongue as evidenced by the fact that he is not a gossip, can keep confidences, and is not a critical person. <i>1 Tim. 3:3,8</i>
