

Sermon Series: PRAY LIKE...
Pray Like James (James 5:13-18)

**Dr. Brian Stowe**, *Senior Pastor*September 19, 2021

James would be known in church history as "Old Camel Knees" because he spent so much time in prayer. Prayer in the believer's life is extremely serious and cannot be undertaken lightly. We MUST be pure before the Lord.

1. The of prayer (vv 13-15)
A. Good times or bad times; it's a time to pray.
It's time to pray when:
1. l am (v 13a)
2. l am (v 13b)
3. I am (vv 14-15)
"God balances our lives and gives us hours of suffering and days of singing. The mature Christian knows how to sing while he is suffering." - Warren Wiersbe
B. This type of praying is, to the point, and from the heart.
"Most public prayers" are ineffective, because in reality they are intended for mans ears." - Hindson, E.E., & Kroll
2. The of prayer (v 16a)
A. Praying with, and for, is a non-negotiable in the believer's life.
"Private sin requires private confession; public sin requires public confession. It is wrong for Christians to hang dirty wash in public," for such confessing" might do more harm than the original sin." - Warren Wiersbe
B. God mightily when we pray for (and with) one another.
"There is comfort in secret prayer and in family worship, but the man makes a tremendous psychological blunder who cuts himself off from the spiritual tonic of the public worship of God A.T. Robertson
3. The of the Pray-er (v 16b)
A. Righteousness (not perfection) is to an effective prayer life.
"Great is the strength of a righteous mans supplication, in its earnestness." - A.T. Robertson
The key trait of this righteous person's praying? To see the will of God accomplished T.D. Lea
B. Does "sit up and take notice" when you pray?
What now?
1to pray at all times. Determine to pray SPECIFICALLY at all times.
Do you have a prayer list? Make one TODAY!
2. Pray by for someone and their need - and then let them know.
3. What has in you and around you because of your praying?
4. Don't praying for unsaved loved ones and friends to come to Christ.
